4.2	A96 – SC met with the Forres Area A96 Dualling Action Group to discuss their concerns about the dualling between Aberdeen and Inverness. GL said that Forres Community Council had been in contact with Elgin Community Council about joining forces on this particular issue.	
4.3	Elgin Railway Station – recent changes that have taken place at the station were discussed. It was noted that parking has become an issue, particularly around Wards Road and Pond Place. There is a spare piece of land that network rail could use for parking but all are unsure who it belongs to. GL said that there would be some benefit in there being 2 sleeper services.	
4.4	Perth Railway Station – recent changes at Perth railway station will have a knock on effect for Elgin in terms of connection waiting times.
