Strategic Assessments

Strategic Assessments have been completed for four of the five Community Planning themes, with the Moray Economic Strategy forming the Wealthier & Fairer Strategic Assessment. Each strategic assessment identified a number of Key Issues to be considered for inclusion in the 2012-15 Single Outcome Agreement. Thereafter in consultation with partners a Risk Analysis was undertaken.

Key Issues and Risk Analyses will be discussed at the forthcoming theme group meetings, the outcome being the identification of Key Priorities for each theme with any cross-cutting priorities highlighted.

In preparation for the forthcoming meetings it is imperative that strategic group members and partners read their theme Strategic Assessment including Key Issues and Risk Analysis and familiarise themselves with the other themes' Key Issues and Risk Analyses, to help ensure full and informed participation in the determination of Key Priorities.
